Itinerary:

Day-1 (Dwarka Sightseeing):

- On Arrival in Dwarka, Our executive will pick up you and move to your hotel first.
- Check-In your Hotel in Dwarka and take some rest here.
- After Lunch, move towards Bet Dwarka. Cab will drop you near the beach from where you have to hire a boat to reach the temple at your own cost.
- Then visit Nageshwar temple which is one the 12 Jyotirlinga in India.
- Come back and visit some more temples like Rukmini temple, Gopi Lake etc.
- In the evening, if time allows, attend evening Aarti in Dwarkadheesh Temple.
- Have a delicious dinner and Take a rest tonight here.

Day-2: (Dwarka - Somnath):

- 6:00 AM, Get ready to move to Shree Dwarkadhish Temple.
- 7:00 take a holy dip in the Gomti River near the temple. Just after the holy bath Line up in the queue and wait for your turn to Darshan of Lord Krishna/Vishnu here. It is one of the main Char Dham tirth in India.
- 9:00 AM, move towards Somnath.
- On the way, also visit Bhalka Tirth near Somnath.
- 1:00 PM, Reach Somnath. Check-In your hotel and take some rest here.
- After Lunch, visit some local sightseeing places such as Dehotsarg Temple, Prachi Temple, Suraj Temple
 etc.
- 5:30 PM, Go to Somnath Temple which is one of the 12 Jyotirlinga in India.
- After the security check, line up in the queue and wait for your turn to get Darshan of Lord Shiva here.
- 7:30 PM, Attend Light show on the temple lawn at your own cost.
- Come back to your hotel, have dinner and take a rest tonight here.

Day-3: (Somnath Sightseeing - Junagadh):

- 6:00 AM, Visit Triveni Ghat. You can also take a holy dip here.
- After breakfast, move towards Diu.
- On the way visit Gangeshwar Temple.
- At lunch Time, Spend some time here at the Diu beaches and Diu Fort.
- 4:00 PM, move towards Junagarh and visit Ashoka Shilalekh and Goddess Ambe Temple.
- Check-In your hotel and take a night stay here.

Day-4: (Junagadh- Dwarka):

- 06:00 AM, Reach GIR National Park and enjoy the Jungle Safari there.(6:00 to 9:00 PM)
- After breakfast, move towards Dwarka.
- around 6:00 PM reach Dwarka.
- Your Cab will drop you at a predefined place as per your schedule and your memorable journey will end here.

"Dwarkadhish Temple", one of the Char Dham pilgrimages, is situated in the city of Dwarka in Gujarat. Dwarka lies on the banks of river Gomti, in Saurashtra. It is historically considered as the capital of Lord Krishna. The city eventually submerged under the sea except for Temples. Its exquisitely carved shikhar, reaching 43 m high and the huge flag made from 52 yards of cloth, can be seen from as far away as 10 km. The grandeur of the temple is enhanced by the flight of 56 steps leading to the rear side of the edifice on the side of the river Gomti. Hindus believe that the original temple was constructed by Vajranabh, the great grandson of Krishna, over the residential palace of Krishna. It was destroyed by Sultan Mahmud Begada in 1472. The current temple in Chalukya style was constructed in the 15-16th century.

The Nageshwar Temple is home to the Sacred Nageshwar Jyotirlinga. It is one of the first Jyotirlinga to be established and is believed to be the seat of Divine power of Lord Shiva. The Jyotirlinga is in an underground sanctum. The major attraction of this temple is a 25-meters tall statue of Lord Shiva in a large garden with a pond surrounding the statue. Legend goes that it was here that a demon called Daaruka imprisoned a Shiva devotee called Supriya. The chants of 'Om Namah Shivay' by Supriya invoked Lord Shiva who arrived here and vanquished the demon. A self-manifested Shivalinga appeared here and is prayed to this date.







The Somnath Temple is one among the 12 Jyotirlinga in India and dedicated to Lord Shiva. It is located in Prabhas Patan of Saurashtra of Gujarat. It is believed that is the place where Lord Krishna ended his spiritual Lila. The primary structure of the Temple is designed between around 320 and 500 AD. This temple was destroyed many times. According to Puranas, the original temple of Somnath was built in gold by the Moon God 'Soma', then by the sun god 'Ravi' in silver, by Krishna in wood, and in stone by the Solanki Rajputs in the 11th century. he modern temple was reconstructed with the resolve of Sardar Patel who visited the ruins of Somnath Temple in 1947 and then President of India, Dr. Rajendra Prasad, installed the Jyotirlinga in the present temple in 1951. The temple is illuminated every evening. The Sound & Light Show 'Jay Somnath' is also displayed every night, which allows the pilgrims an ethereal experience in the backdrop of the grand Somnath temple and the

holy wave sounds of the Ocean. According to history scholars, the site of Somnath has been a pilgrimage site from ancient times as it was said to be the confluence point of three rivers, Kapila, Hiran, and the mythical Saraswati. The confluence was called Triveni Sangam and is believed to be the place where Soma, the Moon-god bathed and regained his luster.
